

ENVIRONMENT DEBATE AFTER FILM SHOWING

THE Teme Valley Environment Group's free film festival kicks off with Al Gore's eye opening film *An Inconvenient Truth* at The Knighton Hotel on Wednesday, June 13 at 7.30pm.

It will be followed by an opportunity to discuss the issues and their relevance locally with a panel of experts including Alice Goldstone and Gary Cowell.
